After months of preparation, the weekend of the 2009 SANBHC finally arrived. Being the first time arranging such a big event, I was terrified of forgetting something at home. Nevertheless, the “Beemer” was jam packed, maybe overdoing it a teeny bit to compensate for that “maybe I will need this” moment. My challenge for the day however: Getting through the N1 North traffic at 13:00 hours on a Friday afternoon!

Safely arriving at Klein Kariba, I was welcomed by the Klein Kariba Staff and directed to our accommodation for the weekend. After unpacking I took the road down the mountain again to open the registration table and welcome some of the archers arriving at the venue.

Saturday morning registrations opened at 05:00 and arriving at the registration venue, the smell of fresh coffee and a sense of excitement in the air welcomed me. The ladies from the Waterberg Club were already busy doing what they do best. Passing the practice range, I could see some archers already on the line and I noticed the new SANIFAA banners proudly welcoming our archers to the SANIFAA National Championships. The bow inspections were handled by the two “generals” especially imported from the Free State. It was not long before all the archers were registered and with the help of Nico Benade and our new database all the archers were allocated into groups.





The tournament was opened by Anton Dreyer, Vice-President of Bowhunter and after confirming a few rules the groups were called out and the archers were on their way to their allocated targets. We all knew it was going to be hot, but for some of us it was extremely hot with not a cloud in the sky. By 3pm the first archers arrived and I could start with the

recording of the scores. By 6pm all the results were captured, printed and allocated into groups for the next day.

Sunday morning welcomed us with a beautiful day of clear skies and the smell of fresh earth after some rain during the night. After mustering, the archers were on their way to their allocated targets again. By midday the clouds were gathering and it was not long before the heavens opened up for a few minutes. Just as quick as the rain had started – it was all over and I could breathe again.



By 1pm the cubs handed in their score cards and I realised that the crunch time had started. By 3pm we were finished with the capturing of the scores when we realised one group is missing. The “MIA” group were the BH ladies and after a short “S&R” we found them. Some explaining had to be done why they were left to walk back.

Nevertheless, the medal ceremony started an hour late and after a few words of welcome and appreciation from the Bowhunter Vice President, we proceeded first with the awarding of medals followed by the announcement of the archers that qualified for Provincial and National Colours.



The team events were also well supported with the Free State taking the Provincial Team Challenge and the 3 Limpopo Club entries taking top honours with a tie for first position by Bushveld Archers A and Nyala A.

Werdie van Staden from the Limpopo Province received the award for the SANIFAA Archer of the Year – Bowhunter for his achievements during the 2009 calendar year. This is a new award based on an archer's performance during a calendar year and is awarded by the SANIFAA Executive Committee. There will be similar awards for the Field and Indoor disciplines in 2010 as well as a SANIFAA Archer of the Year award which will be announced after the SA National Indoor Championships in May 2010.

Finally, as the 2009 SANBHC draws to a close and a special mention is in order to the hosting club Waterberg Archery, its management committee, members and families. Without their help, support and dedication to the sport of archery and SANIFAA, this 2009 SANBHC would not have been the success it was. SANIFAA Executive Committee and I would like to express our sincere appreciation to all those who were involved in the arrangements and execution of the tournament. A special THANK YOU to Marilet van Niekerk and Nico Benade who helped me with the registrations and score capturing. Without your help there would have been a few more “panic attacks” and my hairdresser would have not been impressed.
